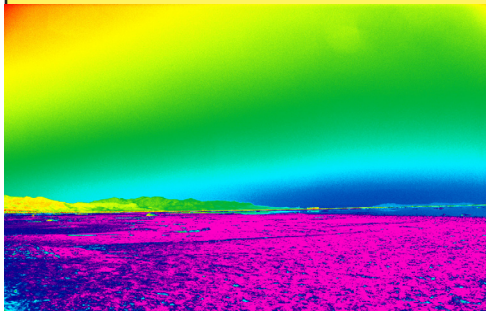

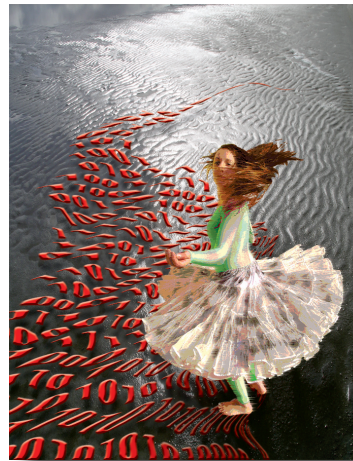
I*nterPlay: Dancing on the Banks of Packet Creek* is an exploration into the tenuous devotion that we have towards the inundating wave of digital information and non-experiential knowledge. Packet Creek depicts the Internet with its flow of disassembled pieces of data that course throughout the world like schools of spawning salmon. Dancing on the Banks is our ritualistic gyrations that we express as we create, disseminate, search, and acquire this electronic epistemological knowledge.

Using the metaphor of fluid motion and dynamics we will portray the immense amount of this non-experiential knowledge and the influence that it has on us. The expansive range between truth and fiction or frivolity and importance are just some areas of creative investigation and artistic expression.

Participants include University of Alaska Fairbanks, Boston University, University of Maryland, University of Montana, Purdue University, Ryerson University-Toronto, Ontario Canada, and University of Utah.

This will be an exciting blend of images using the Access Grid Video Conferencing Technology into a Real-time Collaborative Surrealistic Cinematic Performance

Local live performers include Beth Miklavcic building a Zen Garden with images of the Salt Lake and the Spiral Jetty displayed on a visualization cluster in the background with Kate Bradford stringing the room into a web. CDT dancers Joni Urry Wilson and Alyssa Wilson in the building's stairwell, and sculptor Adam Bateman constructing an art work live in the lobby.

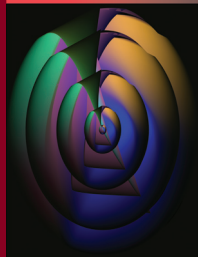
We are working on a history project dedicated to preserving a period of time that no longer exists. From the 1980s through the 1990s our company performed so much and provided so many opportunities for other artists in town to present their work, all on a shoestring budget. This was during a period of time when every year there were more and more cut backs in the arts. We are one of the few Utah art companies, founded in the 1980s, to survive.

For three months Beth Miklavcic has been encoding Beta, VHS, 8mm and mini-dv tapes converting them into raw QuickTime capture files. She has filled up four terabyte drives with these videos. The original tapes are very hard to see especially compared with today's technology, but they will be cleaned to the best of our ability, with a few audio and video filters, then converted to MPEG-4 movies and finally linked to the Another Language website. This is a long-term project and we will share periodic updates about this preservation endeavor.

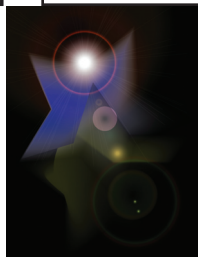
